# COMMUNITY BULLETIN

Today, September 10, 2012, there has been an announcement that the Kitselas Treaty Negotiators have signed a Letter of Understanding with British Columbia and Canada at 12:00 at the Northwest Community College Longhouse.

The Letter of Understanding is an agreement that negotiations to this stage are finished. Now the AIP has to be reviewed by the Kitselas people. We propose to hold the community approval vote in February, 2013.

The outcome of that vote will determine whether or not we proceed to final treaty negotiations.

Kitselas, British Columbia and Canada will have to take the AIP back to their community or Cabinets for the approval process before the AIP can be signed.

Following today's announcement, as promised, the Kitselas team is distributing copies of these documents: the draft AIP, an overview of the AIP (or plain-languages summary), as well as a summary booklet of the most important points.
